 - IT

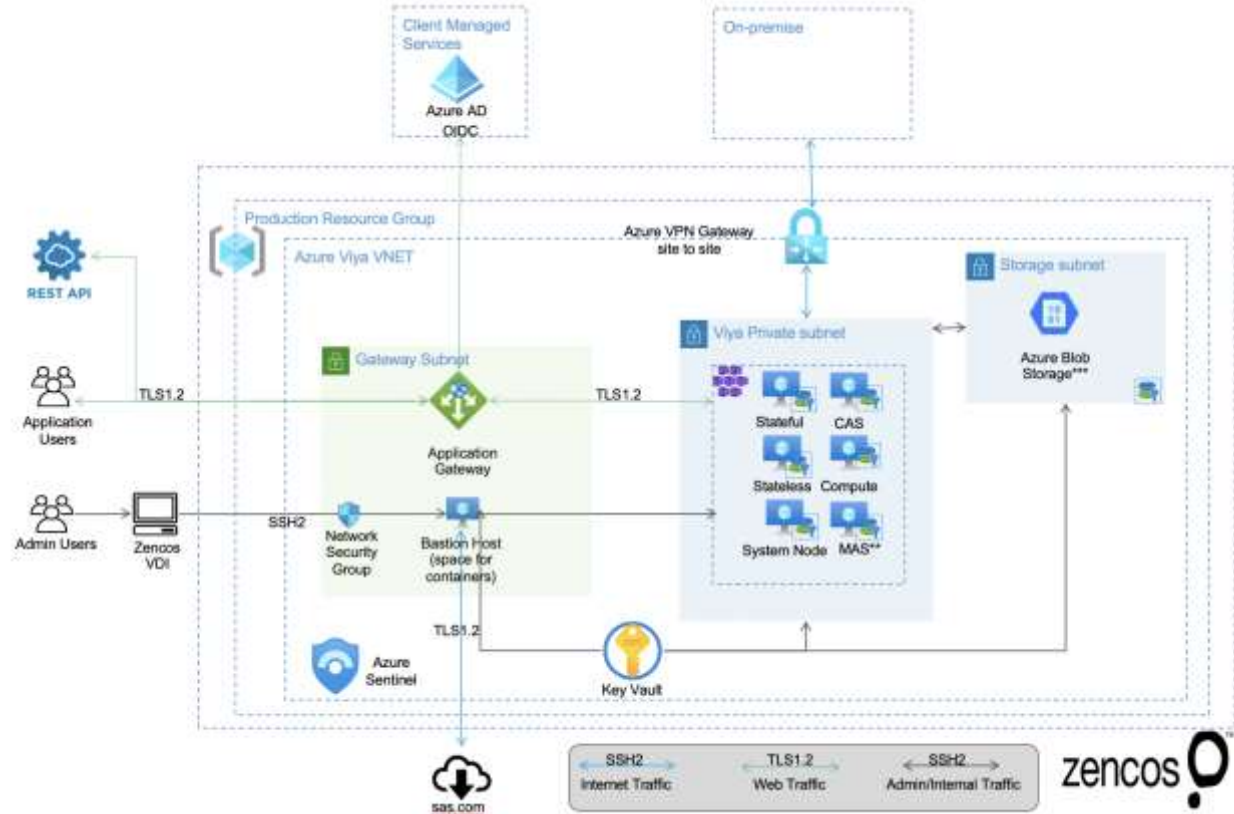

- Understand limitations for migration

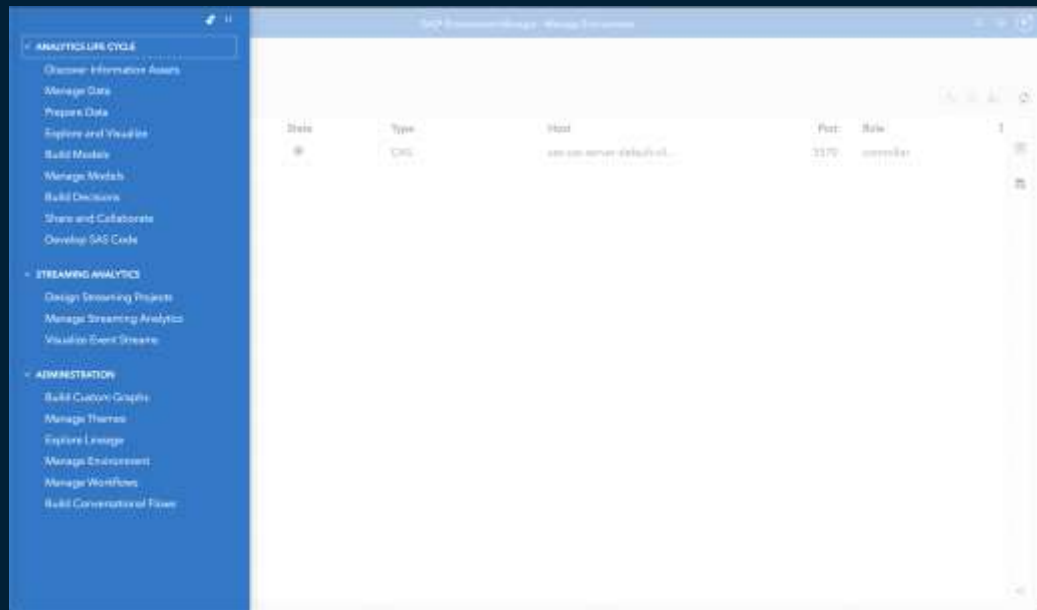

Benefits of Migrating

- Better integration with other cloud systems and cloud native databases
- Less rigid deployment model
- Tighter organizational integration for security (SAML/SCIM)
- More modern interfaces and integration with other systems
- More frequent updates and releases
