


On the training image for **Module 2: Big Data Programming and Loading**, it is possible for various reasons that Enterprise Guide users will find themselves in a mode where they are using the incorrect connection profile. The result is that their programs will run on the local SAS install instead of running on the remote SAS Server. The programs need to run on the SAS Server. In most or all cases, running the programs on the local SAS install instead of the SAS Server will lead to errors or incorrect results. This document describes how to recognize when this issue occurs and how to resolve it.

Issue:

You are using Enterprise Guide with **no profile selected** and SAS code is running on local SAS install in the Windows client machine instead of the SAS Server.

How to recognize the issue:

Look to the lower right of the Enterprise Guide application interface. If you are running in **no profile selected** mode you will see the words "No profile selected" as shown below.




How to fix the issue:

1. Select **File --> Exit** to close Enterprise Guide. Do NOT save changes to the project. If you do, the programs in the project will remain assigned to run on the local SAS software instead of the SAS Server.


*NOTE: IF you want to save changes to a program you have created or modified, you can right-click the program in the process flow and select **Save --> <name of program>**. Once you have saved the program file you can then add it to an Enterprise Guide project later.*

2. Re-start Enterprise Guide.


3. In the Enterprise Guide application, click the text "**No profile selected**" that appears in the bottom right of the application interface (see the first screencapture above).
4. In the Connections window, select **student**.



5. Click the Set Active button.




- In the Credentials Required window type **student** in the User: field and **Metadata0** in the Password: field.



Note: if you earlier chose to store your credentials in the profile you may not be prompted for these credentials. In that case you can proceed to step 8.

- Click **OK**.
- Click **Close**.
- Verify at the bottom right of the Enterprise Guide application interface that you are now connected with the **student** profile.



- At this point the issue has been resolved. As you add programs to the Enterprise Guide project the code will be executed on the SAS Server upon submission.
