What is a User Group?

 User groups connect people to share strategies and best practices around a given product.

Why should you join or create a SAS User Group?

- Foster connections and collaboration with other SAS professionals
- Increase your understanding of SAS products and services
- Stay up to date on new offerings and the latest techniques
- Enhance your leadership and presentation skills

- 3. Form a committee or board
- 4. Define UG type, group objectives, structure, leadership, meetings and administrative functions

 Determine if there is already a SUG in your industry, geographic area or company





Confirm Interest/Viability

Many people who have started User Groups have found surveying potential members before formally organizing helps gauge backgrounds, interests & expectations.

Use the survey to elicit opinions about:

- Organization/structure of the group
- Time, length, frequency of meetings,
- Meeting structure



Form a board or committee

• This is typically made up of two to five people who share responsibility for ongoing group activities to help the user group succeed.

- Regional
- In-house
