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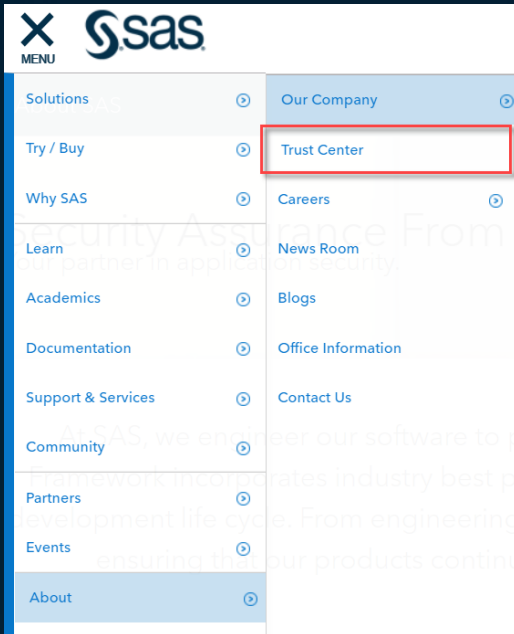

- Contact PSIRT directly by sending email to psirt@sas.com. Information about security vulnerabilities should be encrypted by using our public Pretty Good Privacy (PGP) key

Routine Security Updates

Non-critical security fixes issued on a regular schedule

- SAS 9.4 Maint 6 & 7: quarterly security updates
- SAS Viya 3.5 updated as needed, bundled with other fixes
- SAS Viya 2020.1 and later: monthly releases with features
- SAS Cloud software & services: applied in hosting environment

All software: SAS Notes and Security Bulletins provide detailed instructions to mitigate security issues while patches become available.
